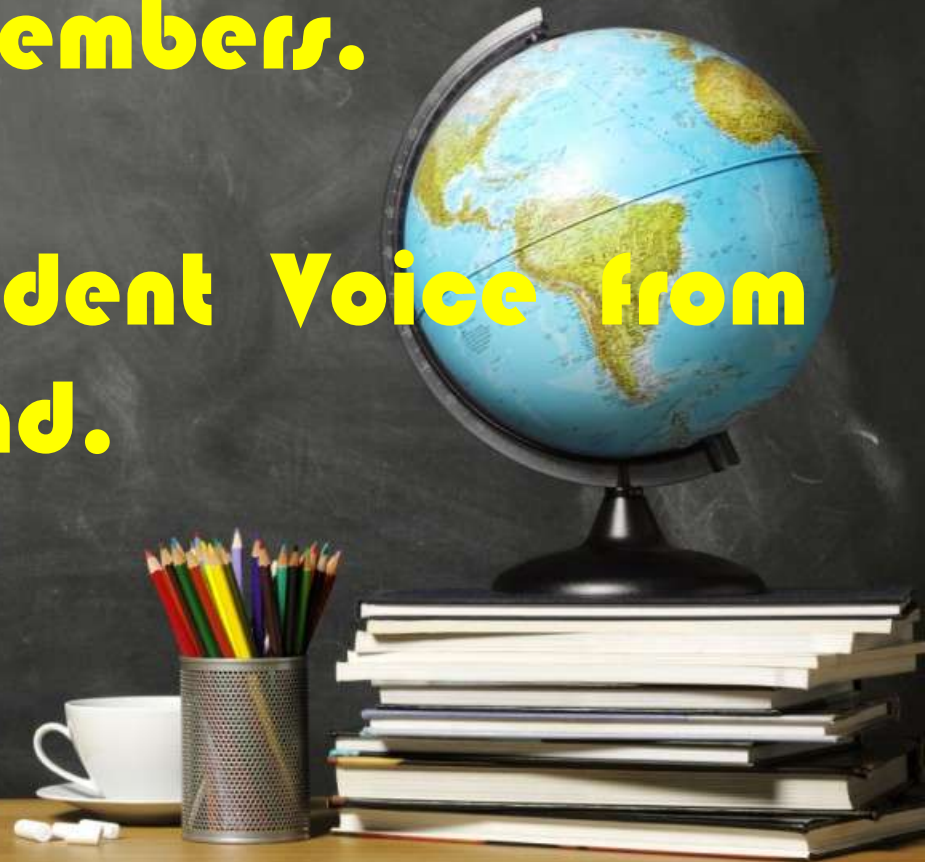

Engineering Maintenance Apprenticeship Torness Power Station, East Lothian

Our **Engineering Maintenance Apprenticeship Scheme** is a four-year programme which focuses on the skills required to maintain our power stations situated around the UK.
