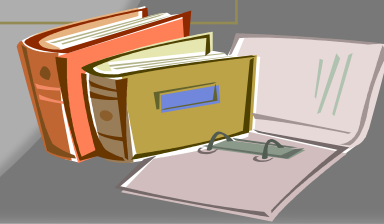

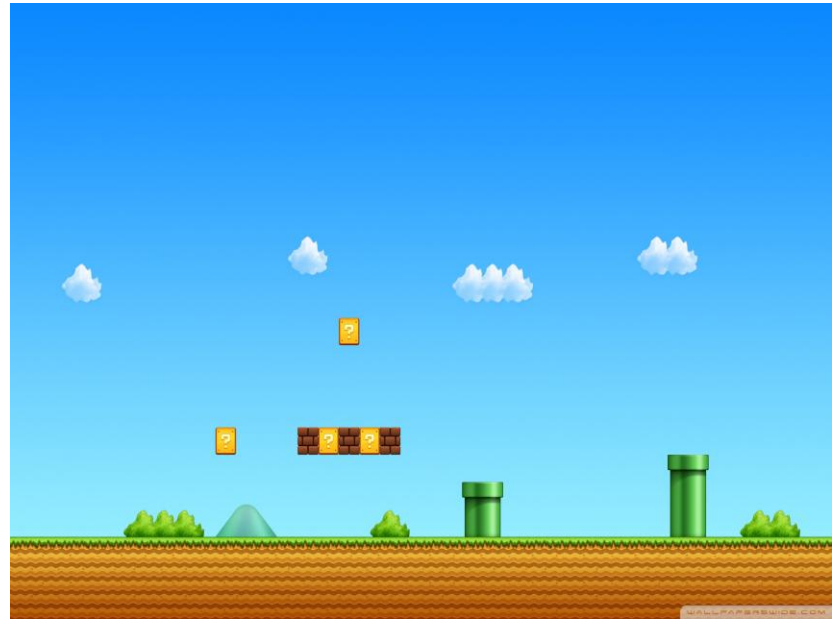

ESOL in Secondary Schools

Midlothian's English as an Additional Language Service presents bilingual students, those whose first language isn't English, for ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) from NAT 4 to Higher.

This is an English Language qualification that carries the same SCQF points as any other SQA qualification. It can be done either in place of or alongside English and counts in addition to it. Typically it involves only one or two periods a week as the teaching required for the units involved (ESOL in Everyday Life and ESOL in Study-related Contexts) is covered by living and studying in an English speaking environment.

ESOL can be used in place of Higher English for entry to most courses at university and in recent years has enabled bilingual students to go on to study at university and colleges where previously they were unable to.

The EAL Service is only able to offer this to Midlothian residents, however some schools are now presenting their exchange students for ESOL and we are happy to provide support to any teachers who choose to do so.

Modern Apprenticeships in Business Administration

The Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) is recruiting two Modern Apprentices in Business Administration to work at their office complex at Lowden, Shawfair Business Park near Dalkeith.

During the two year training programme, Modern Apprentices will work towards a Higher National Certificate in Business Administration and an SVQ3 in Business and Administration.

Entry requirements

Applicants should preferably have, or expect to gain, Higher/National 5 in English, Business Management or Administration. It's essential to have, or expect to gain, at least National 4s in these subjects. A working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint is also needed.
