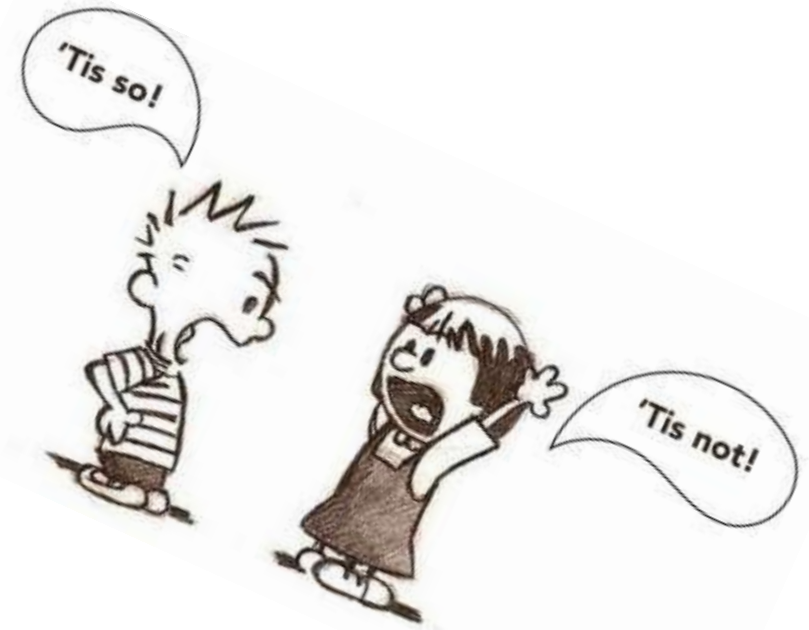

- If anyone has any spare kits, equipment or materials that they would like to donate to this group, or you would like to demonstrate what you make to inspire others, all would be much appreciated!

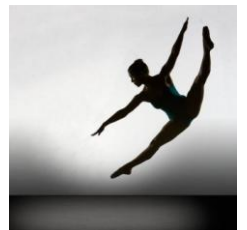


# DANCE SHOW 2018

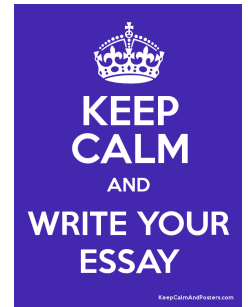
Wednesday 21st March starting at 7pm.

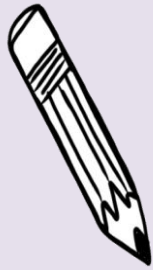
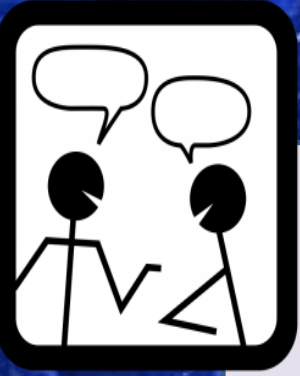

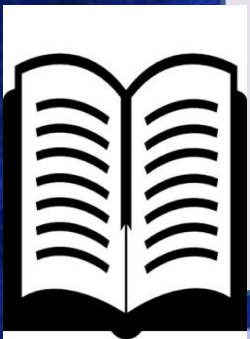
