You will also be invited to take a tour of the campus, including classrooms, workshops, libraries and social areas, giving you an idea of what it's really like to be a student at Edinburgh College.

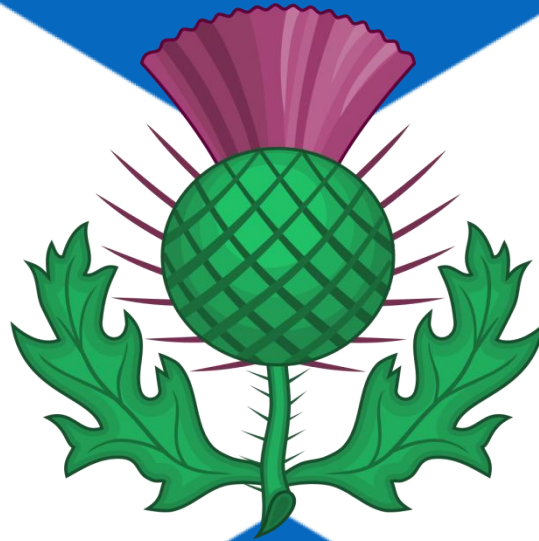
