These books have all been nominated for this year's Carnegie Medal, with the winner to be announced on June 18<sup>th</sup>.

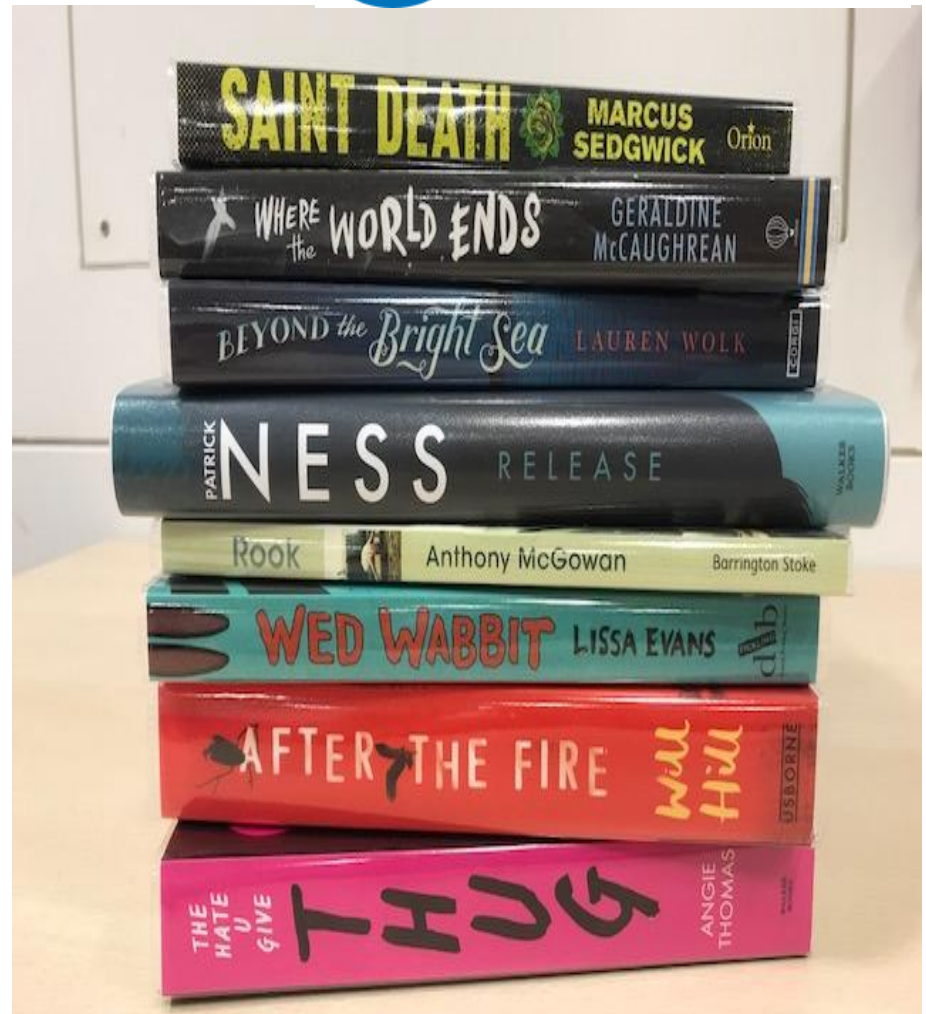
Thanks to funding from the Parent Council, the library has several copies of all of these to read, review and see if we can predict the winner.
