Please note ONLY those Students with Mobility Issues should be using the lift.

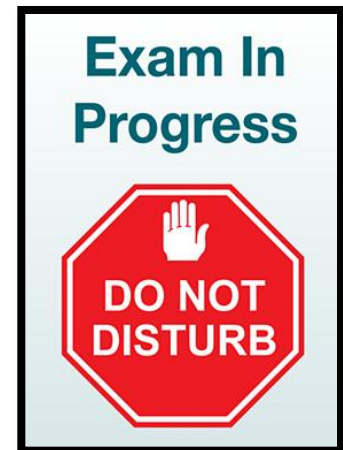
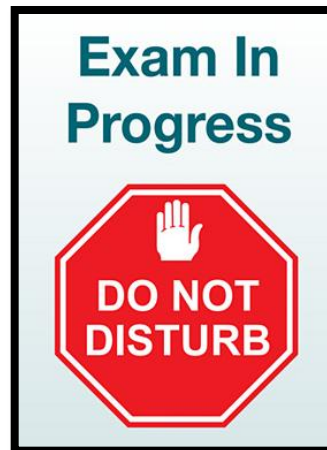
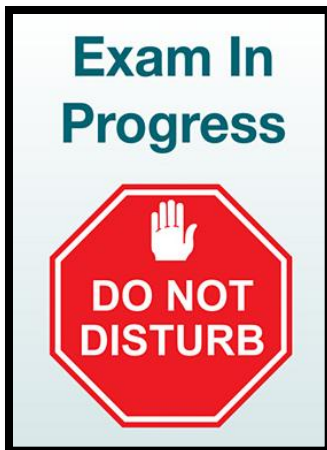
