## **S4 Humanutopia: 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> June**

We have invited an organisation called Humanutopia to visit Lasswade High School to work with all S4 students. The first phase of the project will begin for students on the 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> of June. Your child will be asked to participate in this very exciting and innovative event.

Humanutopia will work with all S4 students in St Annes and St Leonards on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June and all S4 students in Melville and Mount Esk on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June. Each session will run from 8.30am-3.20pm. On their assigned day, S4 students involved will have morning interval at 10.45 - 11.00 am and they will break for lunch at 12.30 - 1.15pm. The school's usual catering facilities will be available at these times.

This initial day-long phase of the project is called 'Who Am I?' and deals with important teenage issues around personal awareness, peer pressure and conformity. It will also encourage the students to reflect on their life chances, encouraging them to have high hopes and aspirations for their future. The day has been designed to help young people discover a more authentic side to who they are.

The experience is designed to empower young people to develop critical life skills and take motivation and ownership of their education. We are certain that this will be a positive and memorable experience for your child and feel it is a perfect complement to their academic studies.
